The Refugee Hub is here to support anyone who is from a refugee, asylum-seeker or migrant background. Our aim is to assist people in gaining the independence and confidence to successfully settle in Australia and enjoy being part of the local community.

We are here to help

Our team provide casework and advocacy support to those who are referred by external agencies or contact the Refugee Hub themselves.

We offer a wide range of services to support you with:

- Referrals to a variety of specialised services
- Assistance with looking for employment, writing resumes and developing interview skills
- Assistance with finding suitable accommodation and resolving tenancy issues
- Assistance with accessing relevant training and educational options
- Advocacy and referrals for legal issues
- Support with citizenship applications and test practice
- · Counselling by a qualified psychologist
- Support in developing safe and happy relationships
- Justice of the Peace (JP) services for certifying documents and statutory declarations
- Advocacy and assistance in relation to Centrelink or the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)
- Assistance with organising payment plans or accessing emergency relief if experiencing financial hardship
- Free access to computers, internet and printing of essential documents
- · Social support, friendships and wellbeing.

Programs

We provide a range of regular programs that aim to promote inclusion, wellbeing, confidence and skills development.

These include:

- Women's Cooking Group (weekly)
- Men's Gardening and BBQ Group (weekly)
- Regular English Lessons and Literacy Tutoring
- Annual Beach Safety workshops
- · Annual Bike Safety workshops
- Annual Soccer Program.
